ARTery serves three main functions for kiwiburn – support, celebration and education of all things Kiwiburn Art. Until now ARTery has been an onsite art gallery featuring Burner art through time and space with a purpose to serve as a mechanism to connect and drive interaction between burners and burner art at Kiwiburn.

We aim to grow the ARTery team so that we can extend artist interaction with each other and the community before, during and after the burn! We also aim to grow our capacity to support and facilitate burner creatives to do what they want to do!

We have lots of fantastic ideas on how to grow our arts community and we need volunteers who want to help us execute this vision! What we can achieve will be entirely up to who is on the volunteer team and what they want to bring to ARTery. Please apply if you want to gift some of your time to developing our arts culture!

Job Purpose

This job description covers all of the aspects of ARTery that we wish to have covered by a whole team of volunteers. You can contribute year-round or just for some times in the year where you have more capacity. You can contribute more to the onsite ARTery or more to the ARTery functions outside of the burn. You can contribute where you have skills and strengths or you can jump in and learn new skills and develop your weaknesses!

Our approach to onboarding our new ARTery team will be to meet with the applicants, see how they want to contribute and what skills they bring and then work as a team to develop ARTery onsite and ARTery year round activities.

Key Responsibilities covered by ARTery team

- Contribution to the development of the arts culture of Kiwiburn Community
- Contribution to the organisation and onsite delivery of ARTery and the expansion in ARTery offerings on site
- HUB decor team makers and designers of the center stage, centre camp and ARTery Decor
- Development and maintenance of ARTery online art gallery
- Development and maintenance of creatives skill sharing network
- Development, organization and execution of kiwiburn art events outside of the burn. Such as: Skills hare events/workshops, art working bees, art showcase events
- Communications with the community around ARTery activites
- Act in a manner fitting of a Kiwiburn member, as per the Memorandum of Understanding.

- Enthusiasm!
- Good understanding of Kiwiburn and Burner culture
- Strong communication skills, especially in an online environment.
- Ability to work collaboratively in a team with integrity and respect.
- Desire to serve the burner community.
- Comfortable learning/using software with regular access to a computer and internet

Some ARTery team members need:

- Event management experience/desire to learn this
- Project management skills
- Experience building or bringing art to burns
- Technical knowledge of electronics, or building techniques that may be used in KB art pieces
